**Bridlington Integrated Transport Plan Phase 2
Update – 21 December 2016**

As you have probably seen, we have signs on site advertising the new one way system to be implemented from 4 January 2017 in Bridge Street and Manor Street.

The new one way system will reverse the current one way in Manor Street. Bridge St will see the introduction of one way traffic flow out onto Hilderthorpe Road. Once the new Bridge is installed on the new Beck Hill link, which is likely to be late Spring 2017, the new circulatory system will be Beck Hill, Manor Street, Bridge Street and Hilderthorpe Road. In the short term, until the new Beck Hill bridge is open, the circulation area will be via Springfield Avenue.

All works will be removed this week for the Christmas period with works commencing again on 3 January 2017. This will include the new one way system detailed above, the conclusion of the utility diversion works on Hilderthorpe Road until mid-February and the continuing of PBS works in Bridge Street and Manor Street.

One thing to look forward to, the Tour De Yorkshire is again in Bridlington in April 2017 and our works will be timed to accommodate the tour.
